

BYLAW NO. 1/88

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF THODE TO PREVENT THE
ENBUMBRANCE OF ROADS AND STREETS.


The council of the Resort Village of Thode in the Province
of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall encumber any road, road allowance or private driveway in the resort village by vehicles or other articles.
2. No person shall store rock, sand, gravel, or any other construction material on the road or road allowance for a period of time longer than necessary for the construction of a building, deck, or improvement to the property.
3. No person shall unpack goods of any kind on the resort village road in such manner that paper, sawdust, or other packing material is deposited or remains upon the road or road allowance.
4. No person shall throw or pile cordwood, firewood, or lumber upon any road or road allowance.
5. No person shall construct a parking facility of any permanent materials on the resort village road or road allowance.
6. Any person found guilty of infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the resort village.
