In 2018 new concrete pads for the Thode launch were installed. This year we will also be adding a new and safer dock beside the launch for use by Thode residents.

Docks & Lifts – permits have been issued for docks located along the shoreline – these docks are **only** for the use by residents of Thode. Please be respectful when moving your docks & lifts on the municipal reserve and do not move property

of other residents to accommodate your own. Items must be tagged with the complete address information.

Shoreline Erosion - We continue our work to address stabilizing the shore. Plans are reviewed with Sask Watershed Stewards and Environment on a regular basis and we continue work on repairs to prevent erosion.

Road Maintenance - Please ensure that all huts, boats and trailers are removed from along the road allowance to facilitate annual culvert and ditch cleaning and road repairs. We have storage sites that can be rented for either a 6 month or 1 year term. Please call 306.492.3333

REMINDERS FROM THE OFFICE

Curb-stops - all curb-stops for water & sewer must be accessible. Please ensure that your shut off valves are marked and easy to access (winter or summer) if required.

Water Meter Readings - Our Council and Management are required by legislation to follow all Occupational Health and Safety Guidelines and we must prevent injuries to staff and eliminate all potential for accidents and risk of injury. Please ensure that your water meter is in a safe and accessible location and remove debris and obstructions from the access path to your meter or meter reader. Our staff will not crawl under buildings or put their personal safety at risk. Property owners are required to put meters and readers in a safe location. Thank you for your assistance.

Tree Debris and Fire Prevention - Please remember that leaves & branches can be hauled to the Dundurn Landfill. Do not pile them in the Village or on Crown land to the west and south.

Boat Launch Key Exchange

The key exchange for the boat launch is scheduled **Saturday, May 14th from 9:00am until 1:00pm** at the Village Office. Please bring your current boat launch key and the \$150 annual fee with you to exchange for your 2022 launch key.

Dock Applications and Policy

Get ready for boating season now, download the forms and fill out the application and send to the Village Office via mail or email. All applications are brought forward at each council meeting where it is considered for approval. The applicant will then be notified of the decision. (See Attached).

Dock Slip Fees

There is a \$150 fee for a dock slip. A boat launch key will be supplied to those who have paid their dock fee. Boat Launch keys are available to other residents only at a cost of \$100.00 per key.

Shoreline Alterations

The Water Security Agency requires the Aquatic Habitat Protection Permit (AHPP) for any and all shoreline alterations including new boat docks and lifts. Please fill out the attached application and return it to the Village Office by mail or email.
