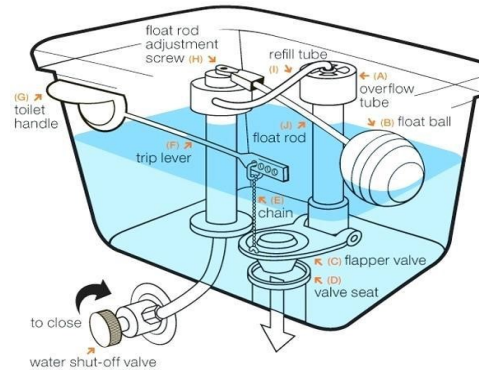


A LEAKY TOILET CAN WASTE AS MUCH AS 950 LITRES OF WATER PER DAY

OR 1,900 EIGHT (8) OUNCE (.5 L) GLASSES OF DRINKING WATER

OR THE EQUIVALENT OF 12 BATHTUBS PER DAY

EVEN IF YOUR TOILET IS NEW IT MAY BE LEAKING - FIND OUT - TAKE THE TOILET LEAK TEST

HOW TO CHECK YOUR TOILET:

Toilet Flapper

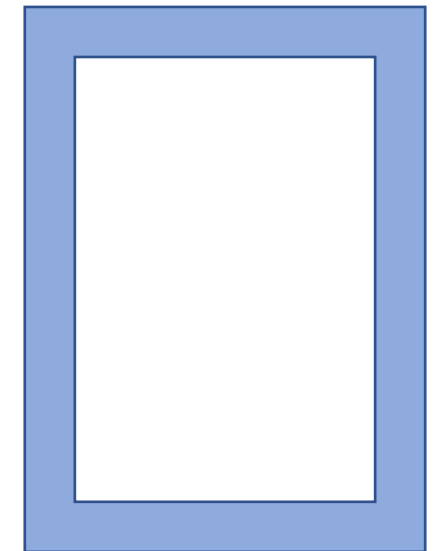


- Take the lid off the back of the toilet and see if the flapper is all the way down on top of the valve seat.
- Remove anything that is blocking the flapper preventing it from closing on the valve seat.
- If it continues to leak, try replacing the flapper.
- A slower leak may be caused by a damaged valve seat which is best corrected by replacing the seat.

TESTING FOR LEAKS**DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. REMOVE THE TANK COVER AND PUT ONE STRIP IN TANK**
- 2. DO NOT FLUSH**
- 3. WAIT 20 MINUTES,**
- 4. IF THE WATER IN THE BOWL STAYS CLEAR - THERE ARE NO LEAKS**
- 5. IF THE WATER TURNS BLUE – THERE IS A LEAK IN YOUR TANK**
