

BYLAW NO. 4/12

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF THODE TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF RENT OR SERVICE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF SEWER

COUNCIL of the Resort Village of Thode, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
2. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
3. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service (the service) shall cover a period of three successive months, and shall be rendered on or about the first day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, the service may be cut off. When the service is cut off, it shall not be turned on until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$50 to cover the expenses of turning off the service and turning it on again; provided that if it is required to turn on the service outside the employees' regular working hours, the fee shall be \$100.
4. In the event of a meter malfunction, where consumption is not ascertainable, consumption shall be estimated on a sampling of consumption of like properties within the municipality. When a two year history is available, that history shall be used to estimate consumption.
5. A penalty of 15% will be added to all water and sewer accounts outstanding after 30 days.
6. Each person supplied with water from the municipal system who is not an owner of the property supplied, shall provide a security deposit in the amount of \$500.00. The security deposit shall be refunded upon service being discontinued at the request of the customer, provided all water and sewer usage charges have been paid in full. This does not apply to seasonal users who require annual on and off service.
7. Bylaws Nos. **4/07, 1/10, 2/10 and 1/11** are repealed.

THE rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.

SCHEDULE "A"
TO BYLAW NO. 4/12

WATER RATES:

All properties Connected to the municipal system	\$300 per year billed at \$75 every 3 months (as a minimum charge)
Consumption	\$25/1000 gallons

SCHEDULE "B"
TO BYLAW NO. 4/12

SEWER SERVICE CHARGES:

All Residences with holding tanks
(not connected to the line)

\$200/year billed at \$50 every 3 months

All Residences connected to the collection line

\$400/year billed at \$100 every 3 months
