A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF THODE TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM

The Council of the Resort Village of Thode, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw shall be cited as "The Water Management Bylaw".

INTERPRETATION

2. In this bylaw:
(a) "Municipality" means the RESORT VILLAGE OF THODE.

APPLICATION

3. (1) All properties within the municipality with a dwelling unit shall be connected to the municipal waterworks.
(2) Any assessed owner may apply for a residential water service from the municipality by making arrangements with the Administrator.
(3) Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of the water meter deposit of \$350.

WATER METER DEPOSITS

4. Each person supplied with water from the municipal system shall provide a meter deposit in the amount of \$350.
5. The meter deposit shall be refunded upon service being discontinued at the request of the customer, provided all water usage charges have been paid in full. This does not apply to seasonal users who require annual on and off service.

RIGHT TO RATION

6. The municipality shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any customer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.

SALE OF WATER

7. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.

ACCESS TO METER ASSEMBLY

8. The water meter assembly must be located in an area of the dwelling unit that is protected from freezing (permanent installations only) and must be easily accessible by municipal staff without compromising the health and/or safety of said staff. Staff may refuse to service meter assemblies that are not easily accessible.

DISCONNECTION REQUESTS

9. If a water consumer wishes to discontinue receiving water service for whatever reason (including seasonal service, he/she shall apply to the administrator who will attempt to ensure physical disconnection if possible. If meter removal is required, a \$75 fee will be assessed per event (removal & installation). If the disconnect/connect is outside of business hours a minimum \$150 fee will be assessed (actual fee will be based on time expended to perform the service and any travel costs incurred). If the disconnect/connect is required due to an emergency situation created by the property owner a minimum \$350 fee will be assessed (actual fee will be based on time expended to perform the service and any travel costs incurred). Parts that have been damaged will be billed out as dictated by the situation.

PENALTY

10. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
11. Bylaw #3/14 is hereby repealed.
